1. Resume

- b. Educational background
- c. Arts integration experience
- d. Concrete attributes of an arts integration specialist

2. Arts Integration Specialist Philosophy

- a. Intended goals of an arts integration specialist
- b. Description of how goals can effect change
- c. What you look for when observing arts integration
- d. What expectations you have for a school classroom that integrates the arts
- e. What concrete behaviors can be seen when a school/class integrates the arts
- f. Synthesis of how you as a specialist showcase the goals and intended outcomes
- g. How you can effect change based on the expectations and behaviors

3. Standards Alignment Guide

- a. With revisions based on Sprint 1 feedback

4. Three (3) Arts Integration Lesson Samples with Assessments

- a. Nine (9) assessments, at least one of each type (diagnositc, formative, summative)
- b. With revisions based on Sprint 2 Feedback

5. Professional Development Session

- a. With revisions based on Sprint 3 feedback

6. Professionalism

- a. Organized, user friendly, grammatically correct, appropriate citations as needed
