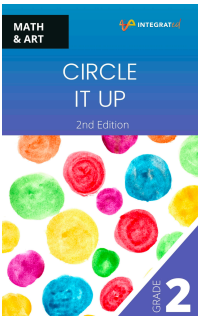

	Technical	Having special knowledge.




	Repurpose	To use something again in an entirely new way.



Image	A visual representation of something.

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
