

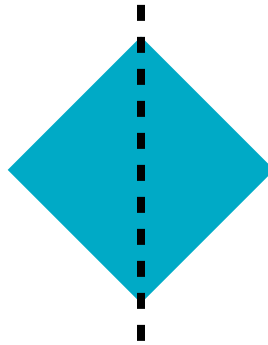


Lines of Symmetry

Symmetry: When a shape or object has two matching halves or one side of something is the same as the other.

Line of Symmetry: A line of symmetry is an imaginary line that divides a shape into two equal parts.



Repetition: Repeating the same movement or patterns of movement over and over.

Retrograde: Performing movements backwards by reversing action (like pressing rewind).

Size: How big or small a movement is.
